Dearborn Contracting Company was recently awarded the Miscellaneous and Ornamental Steel package for The Hamilton by SACHSE CONSTRUCTION. We are happy to have the opportunity to do business

with Sachse Construction. Sachse is headquartered on Woodward Avenue in the heart of Detroit and they are extremely active in Detroit's resurgence.

The improvements planned and underway will result in a completely upgraded complex, with 93 available units. In an innovative approach, Sachse and the City of Detroit's Department of Housing and Revitalization worked together to temporarily move existing tenants out while renovations are completed, according to Curbed Detroit.

The rehabilitation efforts are to include a new ballroom, re-furbished units that range in size from approximately 225 to 800 square feet, and newly designed landscaping features on the exterior of the building.

At the time of this publication, shop drawings are being finalized with the intent of mobilizing on the site in the middle of May. Our work includes rooftop platforms, miscellaneous steel for roof openings, handicap ramp railings, and a new entrance canopy and decorative railings.



Structural Steel at Fischer Automotive Systems

Dearborn Contracting Company is quickly moving forward with the erection of structural steel for the international automotive supplier - Fischer Automotive Systems. As shown, Fischer is connecting two buildings at their Auburn Hills campus. The scope of DCC's responsibilities include the structural steel erection of building steel for Fischer's 56,000 square foot expansion.

Site operations include a crew of (4) Ironworkers, a lead, Structural Superintendent, and an Operating Engineer. The lifts utilize a 70 Ton Crane and the project consists of 135 tons of steel.

Our efforts, with supplier Concentric Steel, is scheduled for completion in the first part of June.
