The work includes the modification of 14 bridge crane systems throughout Final Assembly. Our work includes the engineering, fabrication, and installation of structural steel components supporting these modifications. Some of the system modification includes tying into existing plant steel while other areas involve only new support steel.

Gary Manning is the lead Project Manager and is on-site working directly with Walbridge and Ford. The work is currently under way and it is planned to be completed during the summer shut-down.
