Dearborn Contracting Company and Walbridge have reached agreement on materials, installation, and schedule for the enhancement of exhibits at The Henry Ford’s “Racing in America” promotion. Formerly known as Greenfield Village, The Henry Ford and its museum exhibits and artifacts are world renown. This work adds to numerous projects completed by DCC at Ford’s Dearborn, Michigan campus.

Work activities include the furnishing and installation of support steel posts for a new radius wall display area. The new post configuration is to be fastened to the existing concrete floor to support the new walls. Other work includes multiple, free-standing tube steel frames that are designed to support a unistrut ceiling apparatus. The tube steel frames are to be installed in the area known as the garage or pit area.

The complete project is to be finished by February of 2020. DCC's work includes two mobilizations, one in November for the post installations and one in December for the tube steel frame installations.

Project Management duties are being handled by Luay Nseir and field operations are being managed by Tony Lord. We look forward to being part of the storied past and bright future of what is The Henry Ford.
